What do they need to do?

Step 1 – Volunteer! This can take any form so long as it takes place outside of school. Step 2 – Keep a log. Your child will need to record all of the wonderful things they have done which they can then share with their teacher in the last week of each half-term. This can take any form you like: it could be a list of everything they've done, photos of their activities or testimonials from people they have helped! It can be submitted via the year group email address, on Seesaw or brought into school.

Step 3 – We usually select two winners from the submissions each half-term. These children will receive a certificate, an instant pick of the pot prize and their work will be celebrated on the school website and in our school newsletter. They will also have an instant invite to join the head teacher to share the amazing things they have done too!
