As we have such a wide variety of instruments available, children in Key Stage 1 are welcome to take one instrument lesson and lunchtime clubs. Children in Key Stage 2 can take two instrument lessons as well as clubs.

We also have an ARH Ensemble which is open to all children who can play an instrument; children can join if they have music lessons outside or inside of school. The Ensemble meet on a Tuesday after school for the club with Mr Foster. We are looking for more children to join. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, please get in touch to see how we may be able to help you.

The general costs are as follows:

- Lessons cost £5.00 for small group lessons of 1 to 6 children for half an hour.
- Individual lessons are charged at £11 per 20-minute session, or £17 per half hour session.
- Clubs will be a variable rate based on interest and sizing.

We recommend younger children have group or 20 minute sessions initially.

Practice at home should take place regularly. Initially 5 to 10 minutes a day for 4/5 days a week is enough but as the children progress, this will increase. There will be some instruments available in school for the pupils to hire, at a small charge. You are welcome to buy your own instrument and the teachers can advise on this once they are in contact. For some instruments, there may be a music book to buy to allow your child to practise at home. If you have any questions about any of the instruments, please contact jamesfostertuition@gmail.com
