

PARENTAL POP-INS

We are very excited to be launching our new parental pop-ins! These are a great way to engage with your child's learning, get to know their class teacher and get a sneak peek into their daily life at school. We will be holding trial sessions this half-term on the weeks beginning 31.03.25 and 07.04.25. Each year group's session will take place on a different day so please check the timetable below to see when your child's session will take place.

Younger siblings are welcome to these trial sessions but please ensure pushchairs are stored outside of the classroom..

KEY DETAILS

On the morning of your parental pop-in, please line up with your child; you will be coming into school with them. The usual morning learning will be taking place in class and you can talk to your child about what they are doing and see how they are getting on. The pop-in will end at 9:05am at which point you will need to make your way out of the school building and leave the school site promptly; members of staff will be on hand to guide you out. The school gates on Avebury Avenue and to Anstey Lane will be kept open until 9:15am on these days - all other gates will be closed.

These sessions are:

- A chance to explore your child's work
- An opportunity to celebrate their achievements
- A way to understand the learning taking place in class
- A time to engage with classroom activities alongside your child
- A relaxed and informal visit to experience school life.

THINGS TO NOTE

For these sessions to run smoothly, it is important to remember the following:

- This is not an opportunity for one-to-one conversations with your child's class teacher or a time to raise concerns. Please book a meeting if there is something you wish to discuss.
