Within Literacy and during free flow we will be focussing on:

- Pronunciation and how we say the sounds of letters.
- Rhyme, learning how to recognise it and finding matching
- The initial sounds of different objects and words,

- Having a go at writing more accurate letters,
- Having a go at writing our names,
- Looking at different types of books and learning about the main features of them.
- Reading 'Beegu', 'Pirates Love Underpants', 'The Night Pirates'. The Smeds and the Smoos' and 'You Choose.'





Understanding the world (Science/Geography/History

In our topic lessons and during free flow we will be:

- Exploring and talking about different forces that we might feel,
- Exploring different types of travel and transport,
- Exploring forces of cars on a ramp, experimenting with the height and the texture of the ramps,
- Exploring different types of 'worlds' like the ocean and space,
- Exploring space, the sun and the planets,
- Exploring pirates, fairies and mermaids through role play,
- Looking at the differences between ourselves and others.





Mathematics

Within Mathematics and during free flow we will be:

- Counting out different amounts and saying how many there
- Counting in order and marching numerals to quantities
- Comparing quantities using language such as more and fewer
- Exploring positional language
- Learning how to sequence events using the correct language such as first and then
- Working with numbers to 5, counting, ordering and recognising the numerals

We will be focusing on:

- Learning how to copy the sounds, pitch and tone in different songs.
