Our theme for Summer Term is:

World Explorers & Animal Whisperers

Our main focuses are:

- Locating the 7 continents and 5 oceans using globes and atlases.
- Learning about animal groupings and what different animals eat.

Personal, Social and Health Education P.S.H.E.

In P.S.H.E we will be thinking about what money is and how we keep it safe.

Computing

In Computing this half term, we shall be focusing on E-Safety and thinking about the uses of technology at home and in school. We will think about who we can trust when using technology and where I can go for support. We will consider the importance of being kind online and using the SMART safety rules.



Behaviour and Safety

This half term, we will be thinking about how to be a good friend. We will be looking at what makes a good friend and how we can be one to others. Think at home about times when you have been a good friend and times when you could have worked harder to be a better friend.



Physical Education (P.E.)

To keep us fit and healthy during the summer term we will be learning about agility and co-ordination. We will focus on speed and the skill of negotiating space and obstacles. We will also be practising for Sports Day!

English:

Novel Study: Miranda the Explorer.

In Week 1, we will be exploring our novel Miranda the Explorer. We will be making a prediction about the book. We will then read the story and answer inference questions about what we have read. Using this we will create a story board of the main events.



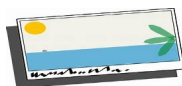
In Week 2, we will be focusing on writing a character description of Miranda the Explorer. We will look at generating adjectives to describe what Miranda is like in terms of her appearance and personality.

In Week 3, we will be focusing on grammar. We are going to be detectives, searching for capital letters and full stops as Miranda travels further around the world. We are going to talk about the countries Miranda has visited and how we can describe them using our five senses. We will use these ideas to help us write a setting description about one of the countries Miranda has visited.

In Week 4, we will be reflecting on our trip to Manor Farm and what we enjoyed about it. We will create a plan and write a letter to say thank you and to tell the staff what we learnt from this exciting experience.

In Week 5, we will be writing our own recipes linked to our D.T. week. We will be looking at different ingredients and how these ingredients can be put together to make a recipe.

In Week 6, we will be reflecting on our time in year 1 and writing about the highlights of the year ready to tell the current Reception children all about what they have to look forward to in the year ahead.



Science

In Science, we will be learning about different animals and how to identify them. We will also be looking at different animal groupings such as reptiles and mammals. Then we will be learning about different animal diets and grouping animals based on whether they are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.

Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring globes and atlases and understanding what we use these for. Then we will be looking at what an ocean is and naming the five oceans of the world. We will also be looking at the 7 different continents and where these are located.

D.T.

In Design and Technology, we will be planning and making 'fruit rumblers'. We will be learning about the different tools required to prepare food and how we can use them safely. We will then be looking at the differences between healthy and unhealthy food.



Mathematics:

Our Mathematics will be linked to our topic where possible. This half term we will be thinking about:



- Board Games Week

We will be designing and making our very own board game linked to our topic.

- Multiplication and Division.

We will be reviewing our understanding of multiplication and how we can use arrays to solve multiplication problems. We will be consolidating our understanding of division by sharing and using this to help us to find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$.

- Measures

We will be revisiting our learning about different measures including length, weight and capacity.

- Partitioning and Place value

We will be reviewing our understanding of partitioning and place value and how we can use base ten to help us. We will look at combining numbers together.

- Shape

In our final week of term we will be reviewing our understanding of 2D and 3D shapes. We will review recognising and naming both 2D and 3D shapes.



Art

Here we will be giving the children a range of opportunities to develop their creative skills as well as helping them plan, design and evaluate their own work.

We will be drawing and painting St Basil's Cathedral. We will be using paint to develop our imaginations and we will be comparing architectural structures with our own creations.



Music

Pupils will develop their performance skills through the unit 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' from Charanga. They will embed skills, knowledge and understanding through singing, playing, improvising, composing and listening.

R.E.

We will continue our learning on Hinduism with a focus on prayer, worship and looking at the differences between a temple and a church.
