PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT 2015-16

What is it?

Pupil Premium is a grant which is allocated to schools. The Pupil Premium Grant for 2015-16 is allocated to schools with pupils on roll in January 2015 that have been known to have been eligible for free school meals at any time during the last six years. Each of these pupils will attract a specific amount of money each year which must be spent to improve their education. If you think your child is eligible for free school meals please contact the school office for further information.

During 2015-16 the school has been allocated £186120.

The grant is used to support interventions to help narrow the attainment gap between groups and increase the overall attainment across the school.
