

Home Learning: Week 6

Monday

Phonics / Writing Activity:

Today's focus sound: ch
(Please look at the Phonics sheets in the resources section.)

Maths Activity:

Time:

Go on a hunt around your house. How many clocks are there? What are clocks for? What do you notice is on the clocks?

Creative Activity:

Make jewellery using pasta and string.

Physical Activity:

How many star jumps can you do in 2 minutes?

Extra Activities:

Make a weather chart and record the weather for the week. Write the days of the week on the chart and each day draw a picture to show the weather for that day. At the end of the week, see how many different types of weather there was.

Enjoy playing some games on your iPad or tablet.

Tuesday

Phonics / Writing Activity:

Today's focus sound: sh
(Please look at the Phonics sheets in the resources section.)

Maths Activity:

Time:

Make a clock with numbers 1–12 and 2 hands that are able to move.

Creative Activity:

Shadow drawing. Take some objects/toys outside and draw around their shadows.

Physical Activity:

Play a game of bowling with a ball and some empty bottles/cans. How many can you knock over?

Extra Activities:

Turn off the lights! Grab a torch and read in the dark.

Think about people who help us. Choose 1 of these people and make a costume for you to dress up in. Role-Play being the person who is helping. What would you do? What would you say?

Wednesday

Phonics / Writing Activity:

Today's focus sound: th
(Please look at the Phonics sheets in the resources section.)

Maths Activity:

Time:

Make o'clock times using the clock you made yesterday. Remember that the big hand always needs to be at the 12 to show o'clock times!

Creative Activity:

Can you make a boat that will float in the bath? Think carefully about which materials you will use.

Physical Activity:

Blow up a balloon or get something soft and play tennis with it.

Extra Activities:

Write a list of 5 things that you are grateful for.

Have a look around your home. How many different types of technology can you find? Which room has the most electrical devices? Talk to your grown-up and find out what they are used for.

Thursday

Phonics / Writing Activity:

Today's focus sound: ng
(Please look at the Phonics sheets in the resources section.)

Maths Activity:

Time:

Make half past times using the clock that you have made. Remember that the big hand needs to be pointing at the 6 to show half past times!

Creative Activity:

Create a new creature using different parts of different animals (e.g, a dog's head, pig's body, horse's tail).

Physical Activity:

Ride a bike or scooter.

Extra Activities:

Make a video reading your favourite picture book. Share it with someone who would enjoy it.

What melts in the sun experiment. Choose some things from your house and put them on a tray in the sun. Make predictions of what you think will melt. Then observe and record your findings.

Friday

Phonics / Writing Activity:

Think about someone who is special to you. Write a letter to them to tell them why they are so special. Maybe you could post it to them to make them smile!

Maths Activity:

Time:

Make a timetable of what you do in the day with the time to match. What time do you wake up? What time do you eat lunch?

Creative Activity:

Make some playdough (recipe in resources) and have fun making different models.

Physical Activity:

Play musical bumps with your family. Who can sit down the quickest?

Extra Activities:

Look at photos of you when you were a baby. Think about how you have changed. What is the same and what is different?

Use the internet or books to find 3 facts about your favourite animal.
