For our last Maths activity of the week, we will be looking at multiplication word problems! Here's what they look like!

Jenny had 3 bags that each had 5 apples in. How many apples did she have altogether?

This tell us how many groups or 'lots of' we need.

This tells us how many is in each group.

See if you can have a go at these word problems!

Mrs Fowler finds 6 P.E bags. Each P.E bag has 2 shoes in. How many shoes does she have altogether?

Miss Venning has 4 pencil cases with 10 pencils in each. How many pencils does she have?

Miss Knight goes to the shop and buys 7 bunches of bananas. Each bunch has 5 bananas. How many bananas does she have?

Miss Fisher buys a 3 bags of crisps. Each bag has 10 crisps in. How many crisps does she have?

Mrs Mwenya has 5 book bags with 5 books in each bag. How many books does she have?

CHALLENGE: Mrs Fowler, Miss Venning, Miss Knight and Miss Fisher are having lunch around a table. How many feet are under the table?
