

# Reading Punctuation

Today we are learning how to change our voice to read different punctuation. Listen to the clip of Mrs Fowler reading these three sentences and see if you can do the same with the last three sentences.

When we see a full stop we pause.

I can't believe it! Ice cream for breakfast!

When we see an exclamation mark, we raise our voice.

How long will this take? Is it lunchtime yet?

When we see a question mark, we make our voice go higher at the end.
