



Learning objective: To create a memory map of your garden.


This PowerPoint takes you through looking at maps and why we use them! We are then going on an adventure around the garden to make a memory map of your garden. Encourage the children to think about what they can see on their journey and where these things are. They can pick up items to stick on, draw their map or take some pictures to help them remember!

Don't worry about completing it in one day as this could take you 3-4 days!



map?





 - * To find treasure!






Go out into your

Now you've collected everything you need for your map let's get started!

We're going to use everything we've collected to make a memory map!

Do you know what a memory map is?
Tell your grown up in a funny voice!

That's right! A memory map is when you show a journey to somewhere using your memory of what you saw. You can stick objects on to help you!

Did you get it right?

Now, let's create a memory map of your garden!

Think about where you started and what you saw first...

You could draw a picture of what you saw or use something you found and stick it on!

For example,

The first thing I can see is some flowers! So I'm going to stick a flower on my memory map! Or you could draw a flower. What did you see next on your journey around your garden?

Keep going around your garden until you get back to where you started!

Remember its needs to be in order of what you saw!
