She was the first person to ever win two Nobel Prizes!




How do you think Marie Curie felt after winning two Nobel Prizes?

Do you think is fair? Why/why not?









How do you think Anne would be feeling?






Luckily, Anne had her diary and she wrote in it every day explaining what happened to her and her family. Anne dreamt that one day she could be a writer!
