Split digraph are two letters that join together to make one sound, but they are split around a middle letter.

cake

These are the split
digraph sounds:

a e like in cake

i e like in bike

o e like in hole

e e like in theme

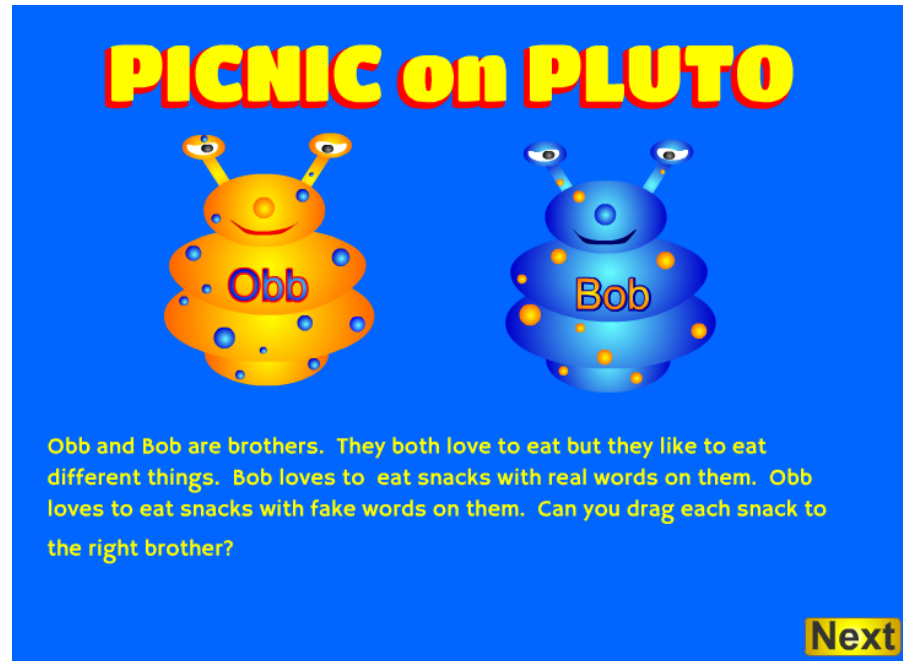
u e like in cube or flute

The only sound you need
to watch out for in the
middle of a split digraph
is a 'c'

rice face spruce

When it's in the middle of
a split digraph, it makes
a 's' sound.

need to select Phase 5.

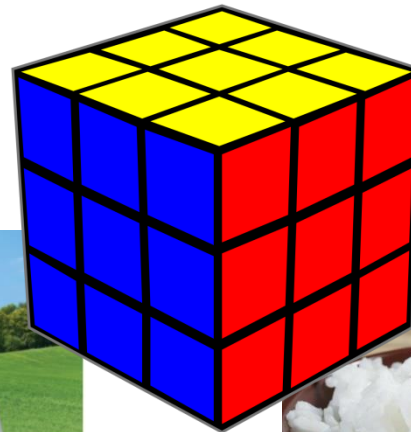
