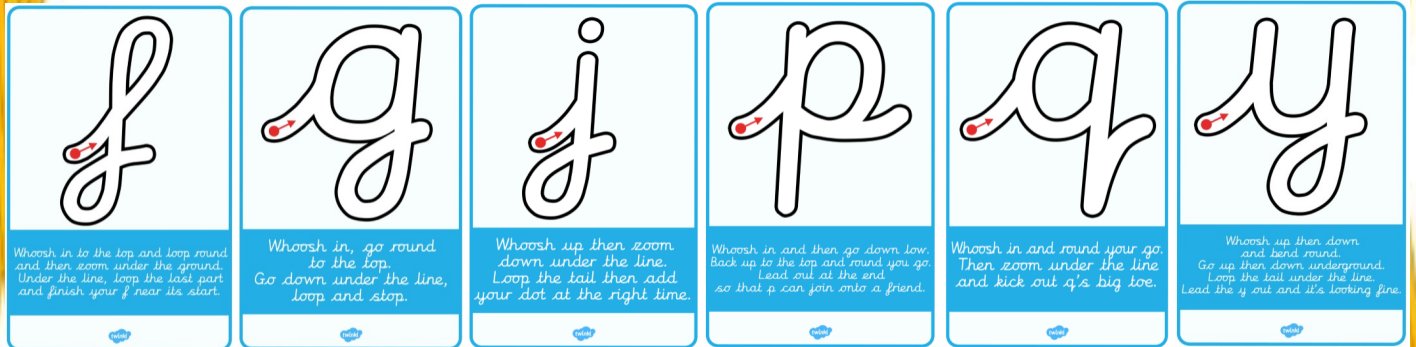
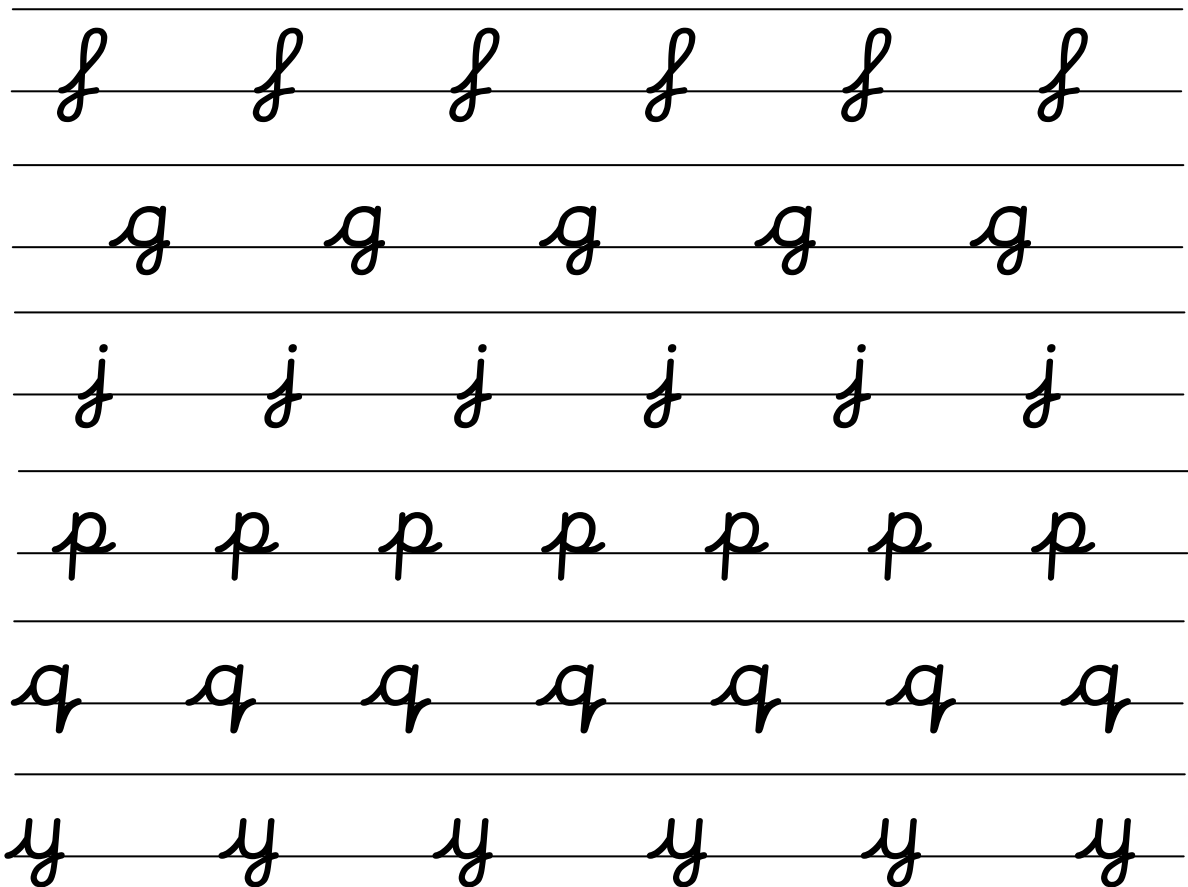


Handwriting

Today we are practising writing 'descenders'. These are the letters that go underneath the line. You don't need to print this sheet, just practise on a piece of paper.



When we write in cursive, we always start on the line. For the descenders, part of the letter goes beneath the line. The rest of the letter shouldn't touch the top. See if you can practise these letters. You might need to draw a line on your page to help you!



If you can write these letters neatly and in the right place on the line, try writing words that start with these letters. Can you keep forming them correctly?
