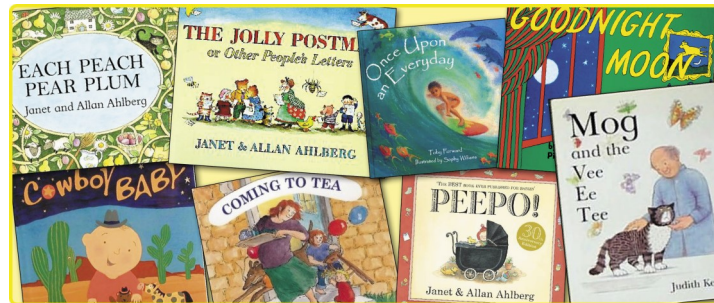


# Book Review -
