

English- Poems!

This week we want you to become poets! You're going to have a go at writing your own acrostic poem. But, what is an acrostic poem? An acrostic poem is a poem that contains only words or phrases. Using a topic word you write it vertically down the page and then think of a word that begins with each letter. Our topic word this week is going to be Family.

Your first activity is to find your favourite poem. It could be online or in a book or maybe it's a poem you've made up before or you was told! Why do you like this poem? What sort of poem is it? E.g. acrostic or rhyming poem.

Now have a look at the acrostic poem at the bottom of the page. What do you notice about this poem? Can you see how all the words/phrases begin with the beginning letter? The word also needs to link with the main topic word, e.g. family is our word so for 'f' you could say fun because your family is fun to be with!
