The Iron Man-chapter 5 questions

- 1) Why was there 'no time to be wasted'?
- 2) Why does the space-bat-angel-dragon laugh when the Iron Man challenges him to a test of strength?
- 3) Why do you think there is so much talking between the Iron Man and the space-bat-angel-dragon at the end?
- 4) How do you feel about the Iron Man now? Have your feelings about him changed from the start of the story?

Reading activities

- 1) The Iron Man was very brave during the battle with the space-bat-angel-dragon. Can you think of a time when you have been brave? What did you do? How did you feel at the time and afterwards?
- 2) What did you think of the ending of the story? Did you like it? Explain your answer.
- 3) You could even write your own ending!

Reading answers

- I) There was 'no time to be wasted' because they had to act quickly. The space-batangel-dragon had only given them a week to prepare for his feast so they didn't have much time.
- 2) The space-bat-angel-dragon laughs when the Iron Man challenges him because he knows he is much bigger than the Iron Man and doesn't think he is any threat. He thinks he can win any challenge.
- 3) There is lots of talking between them because they are challenging each other.
- 4) You might think that the Iron Man has changed from the enemy at the start of the book to the hero at the end? Maybe you have a different idea. Let us know.
