TASK 3

So far we have learnt about 3 new characters in the book; Silky, Saucepan Man and Moonface! We have read their appearance descriptions and drew what we think they look like, we then saw the pictures and described them ourselves.

Next up we are going to use our creativity skills and imagine where they live (think to our topic- habitats!) So, your task is to come up with a home for each character. This can be as realistic or as made-up as you like. You can draw/paint/colour/create on a computer/ use materials where they might live thinking about: their size and the size of the house (if it is a house), what they might have inside or outside their habitat, what colours would there be, would they have furniture, what kinds of rooms would they have?

Once you have created a habitat for each character, think of ways you could describe their home/habitat to a friend. You could write a description of the habitat, you could record your voice talking about the habitat or you could take some pictures of what you have created!

We look forward to seeing these incredible habitats for these unusual characters.

Task 4

Our next task is to use all the fine work we've done so far to help us with a piece of writing. This writing is all about which is your favourite character out of Silky, Saucepan man and Moonface.

We are going to think about: What they look like, what are their personalities like, where do they live and even their names!

Your task is to write down your favourite character and tell your teachers why you have picked that character. What do you like about them? Is there anything you would change? Do they remind you of another character? What questions would you like to ask them?

Think about:

- Questions
- Adjectives
- Conjunctions (because, so, and, if, when, but)

Task 5

Our final task (nooo!) is to compare the three characters we have focussed on so far. We are going to think about how they are similar and how they're different. We'd also like you to think about things you could change about each character (you could even come up with different names.)

Use Google, the pictures above and the descriptions above, as well as all your work so far to compare the three characters; Silky, Saucepan Man and Moonface.

You could set your work out like this:

How are the characters similar?

(Here think about their personalities, where you think they live and what they look like)

How are they different?

(Here think about their different appearances, where you think they live and their names)

What I would change if I was the author

What would you change about any of the characters? Their names? Looks? Why?
