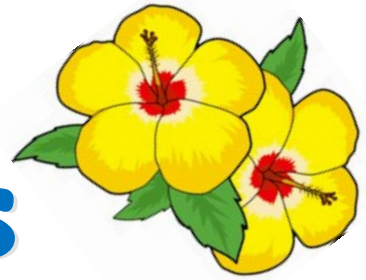

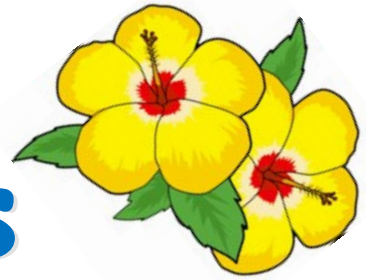



Easter Pictionary

With the people in your household or other friends and family via video calling, have a go at our Easter Pictionary game. The rules of Pictionary are simple. All you need is something to draw on and some writing instruments (pencils, pens, felt tips). You can adapt this game to suit all ages. The aim of the game is to guess the picture being drawn by the 'artist'. You can be put into teams or you can do it individually to one another for fun. The idea is that you pick an Easter word from a bag (you can use a carrier bag). You then need to draw the word you have picked. If your partner/team guess the word from your drawing, they get a point.

Here are the Easter words you can copy out on small bits of paper. You can think of some more if you like.

Five Senses Nature walk

The walking is less about getting somewhere than it is about being aware and tuning into your surroundings.
