Five children are about to make history!

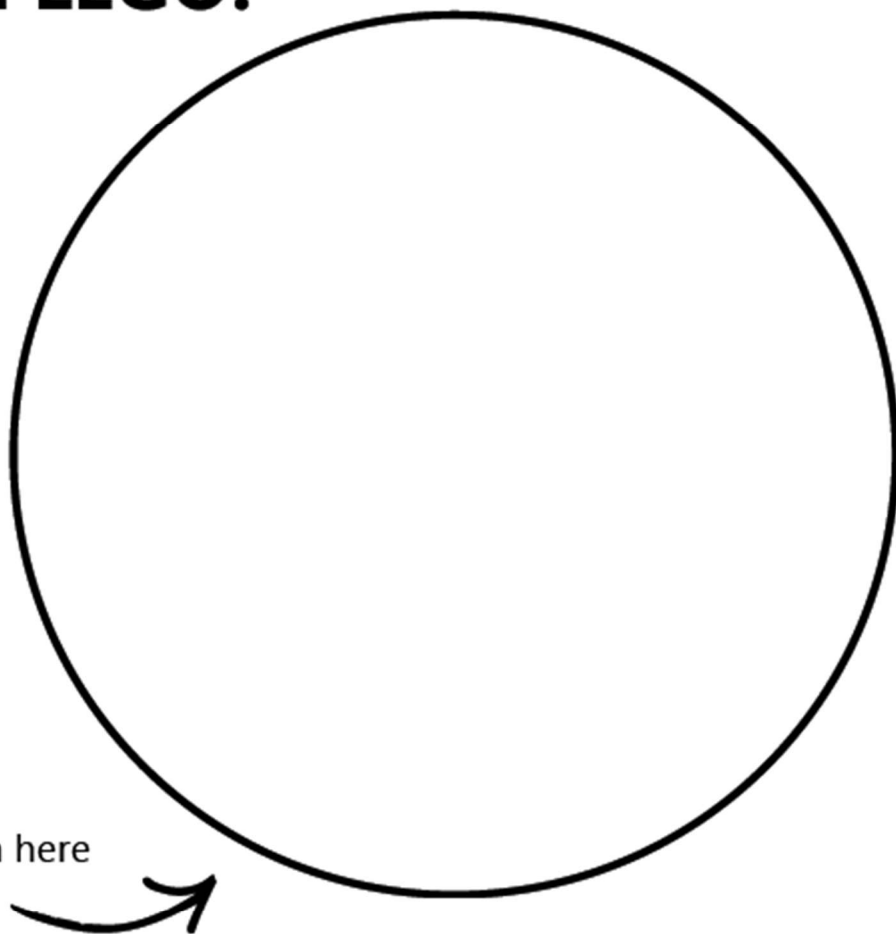
In this story set over 20 years in the future, five young explorers travel from Earth to the Moon on an exciting mission. But every space mission needs a special mission patch.

## **Moon Rescue Mission Patch Competition – Terms and Conditions**

### **1. Eligibility**

- The competition is being ran by the National Space Academy and is open **exclusively to children aged 9–13 years old**.
- Entrants must submit their own original artwork
- Only one entry per person is permitted unless otherwise stated.
- UK entries only.

### **2. How to Enter**

- Design an original mission patch inspired by symbols, colours or pictures you feel should represent the book 'Moon Rescue'.
- Submit your design in a PDF format via email with the subject heading 'Mission Patch Competition' to [NSA@spacecentre.co.uk](mailto:NSA@spacecentre.co.uk) along with the child's name and age and a valid email address to be contacted.
- All entries must be received by **9am on the 30<sup>th</sup> March 2026**.

### **3. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the top three entries:

#### **Placement Prize**

- 1st Place** LEGO set (largest/most valuable set)  
**2nd Place** LEGO set (mid-tier set)  
**3rd Place** LEGO set (smaller set)

- The exact LEGO sets may vary but will be of comparable value to the placement level.
- Prizes are non-exchangeable and cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash.

### **4. Judging Criteria**

Entries will be judged on:

- Creativity and originality
- Relevance to the book's themes
- Visual impact
- Effort and craftsmanship

The judges' decisions are final.

### **5. Winner Announcement**

- Winners will be announced on **31<sup>st</sup> March 2026** via **email**.
- Winners will be contacted using the email address provided during entry.
- If a winner cannot be reached within **7 days**, the organiser reserves the right to award the prize to the next-highest-ranked entrant.

### **6. Intellectual Property**

- Entrants retain copyright to their artwork.
- By entering, participants grant the organiser permission to display, publish, or share their design for promotional purposes related to the competition or the book (with credit given).

### **7. General Conditions**

- The organiser reserves the right to disqualify entries that are incomplete, inappropriate, or violate copyright.
- The organiser may cancel or amend the competition if necessary, due to unforeseen circumstances.
- AI generated artwork is not to be submitted.
- By entering, participants agree to these Terms & Conditions.

### **8. Data Protection**

- Personal information will only be used for administering the competition and contacting winners.
- No personal data will be shared with third parties.
- By submitting an entry into the competition, the parent consents to the child's first name and age to be shared on social media along with the winning entries.
- All data will be deleted 30 days after the competition closes.

- As the competition is open to children aged 9–13, **all entrants must have permission from a parent or legal guardian** before submitting their design.
