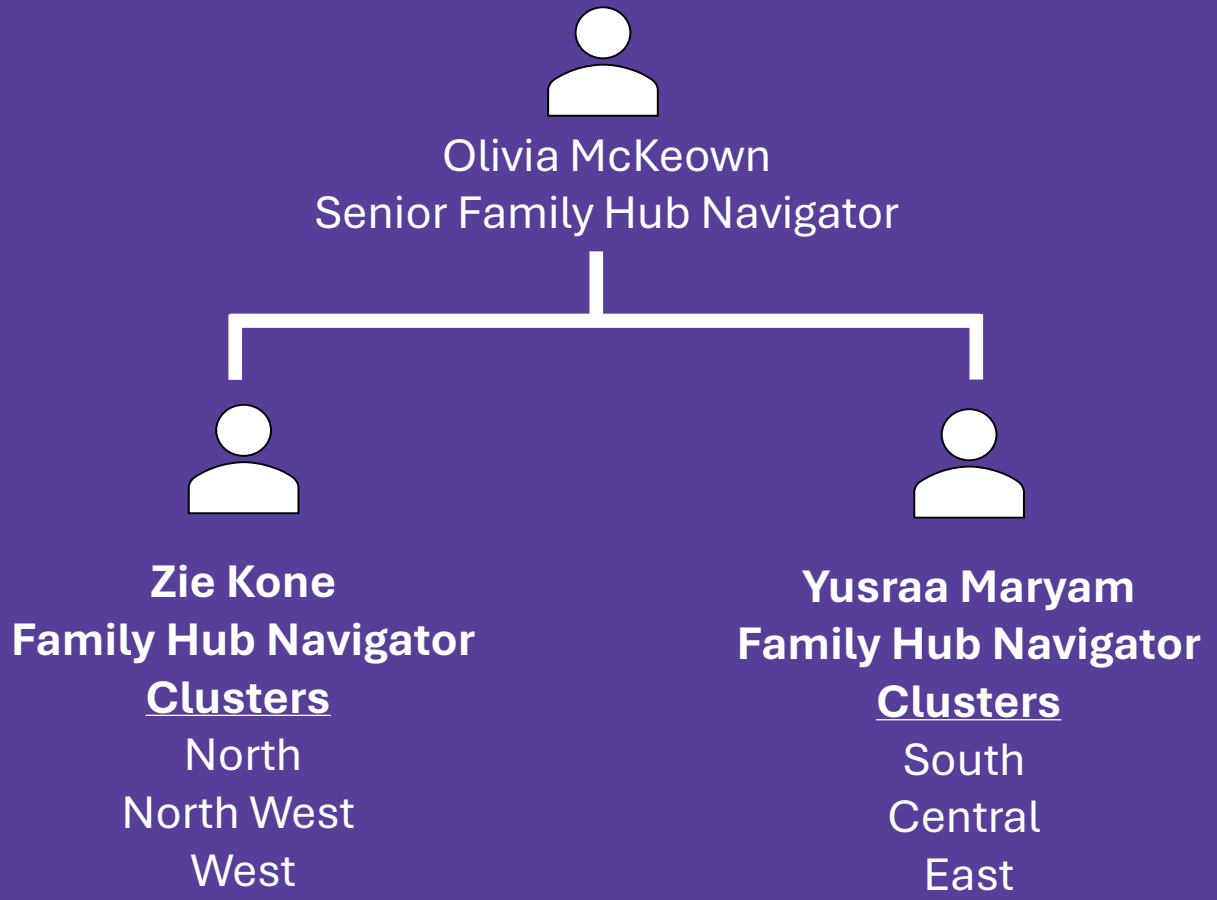

Provide a frontline presence for Family Hubs and act as the first point of contact for families and professionals.

Provide detailed information, advice, and guidance on a wide range of services and/or issues for families.

Refer and signpost families, children and young people to further support, advocating on their behalf with other agencies/providers where necessary.

Connect families with the right support, at the right time.

Support families to build confidence & resilience

Act as a 'bridge' between the community and Family Hubs services.

Support the development of strong local partnerships with schools, early years settings and relevant community organization's by engaging with local partners and promoting the benefits of partnership working.

Increase community awareness of family hubs, family hub services and services provided by the wider voluntary sector.

Referral Process

A family who needs support is identified

Consent is gained from the family to ensure they are happy for their details to be sent to the Family Hub Navigators

Professional to email or call the Family Hub Navigators to give families details & a brief overview of the support they require.
(No Referral Form Required)

A Family Hub Navigators will contact family & provide support

Families can self-refer by calling, emailing or coming into a Family Hub
