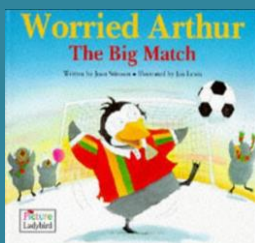
## BOOK OF THE WEEK
