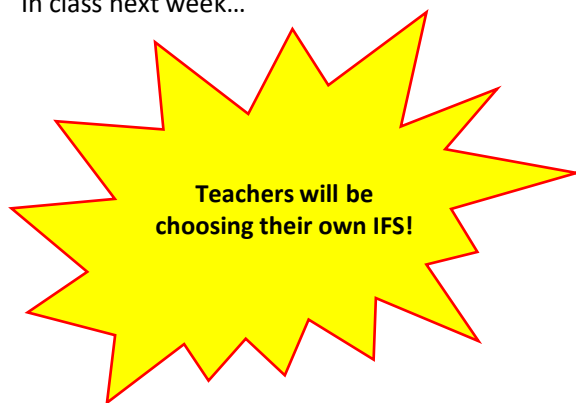
PARENTAL SUPPORT

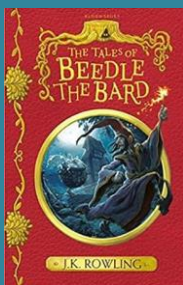


BOOK OF THE WEEK
