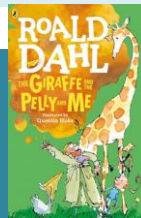
SUPPORT FOR PARENTS AND CARERS

BOOK OF THE WEEK

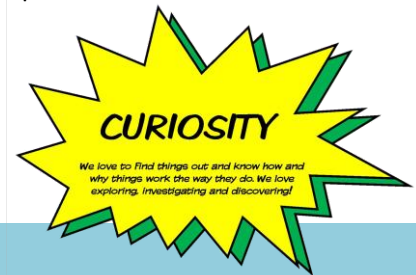
Title: The Giraffe and the Pelly and Me by Roald Dahl
