Title: Curse of Maggoty Skull

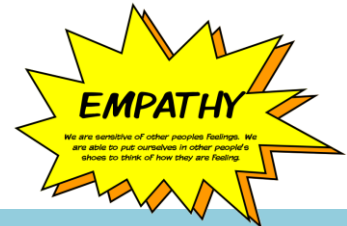
Reading Age: Years 5 and 6
